Preparation Of A New Electoral Roll

Every six years the Church Representation Rules require that a completely new Electoral Roll should be prepared for each parish. This is due to take place in the next two months, and there is a notice to this effect on your church noticeboard. All persons who wish to have their names entered on the new Roll, whether their names are entered on the present Roll or not, will need to complete an application form. Please may I emphasize that no one can stay on the roll without reapplying.

As there is limited time to process the applications, it would help me if you could please respond as soon as possible. If you are a regular worshipper at any of the churches in the Parish of Keynsham please do consider joining. Application forms will also be available in each church and from your Churchwarden. Being on the Electoral Roll signifies that you are a member of the Church and entitles you to vote at the annual meetings, which usually take place in March or April.
